- Row 4: D-flat major/b-flat minor (five flats: Bb, Eb, Ab, Db, Gb), G-flat major/e-flat minor (six flats: Bb, Eb, Ab, Db, Gb, Cb), C-flat major/a-flat minor (seven flats: Bb, Eb, Ab, Db, Gb, Cb, Fb)
